

## **Record of the Swyncombe Parish Council Conference Call on Thursday 26<sup>th</sup> March 2020 from 4.30pm to 5.30pm**

There was discussion on the following issues;

**1 Speed Signs** – (attachments were emailed out)

**Resolved:** That Swyncombe Parish purchase a SID with all the necessary components at a cost of £1409 excluding VAT. This will give SPC a 1/3<sup>rd</sup> ownership and will be available to us for 4 months of the year.

**2 Planning Applications**

**Planning Consultation - P20/S0639/FUL – Little Hatch Stables**

**AGREED RESPONSE:**

SPC object to this application on grounds that it represents an overdevelopment of the site given its close proximity to the other mobile home, and on grounds that it will result in increased traffic movement, habitation, noise and light pollution in a sensitive landscape area within the Chilterns AONB, as well being likely to require an additional sewage treatment plant (STP), which must not be contrary to Policy EP2 (Adverse effect by noise or vibration) of the local plan. We would also point out that the block plan does not correctly reflect the siting of windows on the east side and that the floor plan lacks important detail

**Planning Consultation - P20/S0825/LB and P20/0642/FUL – Westwood Manor Farm -**

These are both for the same building alterations.

**AGREED RESPONSE to both applications:**

No objection, on condition that the application conforms in every respect to Policies CON 1 to 5 of the Local Plan for Listed Buildings.

**3. Covid 19 Plan**– It was noted that a number of shops in Watlington are doing payment over the phone and home deliveries. It was said that it is very difficult to get an on-line delivery order slot from the major supermarkets. Swyncombe have volunteers in the parish who will be keeping an eye on and helping with deliveries/collections. EL said that she thinks that the parish has good cover. Tracey and Dan from the Five Horseshoes are also doing deliveries of essential foodstuffs etc.

**4. Parish News** – PWF had asked the opinion of SPC to if the printing and delivery of The News should go ahead. The SPC view was not to do so as now the Churches have closed, they will not need to advertise the services. It was also noted that delivery of these are not essential journeys. EL said that it would be good if the Church could put out an announcement by email letting everyone know that the Church is closed as some people may be unaware of this.
